Lake Committee Update – Mitch Monis

Richard Bohanon explained that he had talked with the company providing service on the canal water, Solitude, concerning outbreaks of duckweed and watermeal, mainly in the East Lake. 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marine, but were not using a surfactant. Richard asked them to add the surfactant to help with control of the outbreaks.

Jon Buck added that there is not as much watermeal on the East Lake as there had been in past years.

John O'Malley said we should not expect anything to be eradicated because of excess nitrogen in the water. Stan Fizter said that fertilizer that gets into the lake can add nitrogen to the water.

Discuss alternative solutions to the continuing challenge of eradicating duckweed and watermeal from the east lake.

- o There was general agreement that scooping it out is unlikely to be effective.
- Richard said he would make some calls to try to find potential scoopers anyway.

Lake Equipment Update – Don Gwynne

- Fountains
 - Fountain 5 is working now. Water got into the connectors and wires. He fixed it and it is back in the water.
 - Fountain 4 was popping GFCI possibly water in the motor can. He will pull it out of the water and investigate.
 - He measured the current and timers at the other fountains.
- Circulators
 - The circulators are not very powerful and are not designed to be used in shallow water, so they are not very useful, and not very effective, following the dredging that worked well.
 - The canal committee suggested taking them out for now, and Don will make sure they are up to specs for possible.
- Aerators
 - Seem to be working well, Don says the one at the natural end might need to be bigger.

Architectural Committee Update – Jerry Moore

- New wrought iron fence was approved (by Jerry) at 2707 Westwood for the Wallace family now living there.
- A new fence put in at 1505 Waltham was not approved, but appears to be within HOA guidelines.

Directory Committee Update – Shelley Hulme

 Shelley passed out draft copies and asked for feedback. She also sent electronic copies of the directory to all board members and asked them to check on residents in their areas for accuracy.
